Winter Fuel Payments **Payments**

f you were born on or before 5 April 1954 you could get between £100 and £300 to help you pay your heating bills. You usually get a Winter Fuel Payment automatically if you are eligible.

Most payments are made automatically between November and December. You should get your money by 13 January 2020. If you do not get your payment, call the office that pays your benefits - their details are on any letters they sent you.

Some people may need to apply for the payment. Eligibility criteria and further information can be found at https:// www.gov.uk/winterfuel-payment
